## ***SVBPL Scoring Instructions***

1. All SVBPL score sheets must include players **First** and **Last** name for each instance of play
2. BCA division play **requires** each game result include the ball count
3. Non-BCA division play may included ball count for player handicap purposes
4. Ball Count is the number of balls potted for a given player, **not** the # of balls remaining. Balls potted by an opposing player for his opponent count toward the number of balls potted.
5. Record the W/L and the balls potted in the game box (ex. below)
  - a. Ball count for home team players is the upper right corner box
  - b. Ball count for away team players is the lower left corner box

6. All wins are worth 8 balls regardless of the circumstance (ex. early 8-ball)
  - a. 8-ball break is scored 8-0 – see example (“B” may be used to note instance)

- b. 8-ball run is scored 8-x where “x” equals the number of opponents balls potted during the course of the run – see example (“R” may be used to note instance)
